A Note on Sustainability

Sustainability is a relative newcomer to the list of adjectives applied to wine, but ties into a greater cultural understanding of the growing environmental and social challenges we face around the globe. While there are overlaps with Organic and Biodynamic practices, sustainability looks at the winery in the context of a larger cultural ecosystem, taking into account not only agricultural practices and their effects on the environment, but the financial and social practices and their impacts on the community. There are a number of sustainability certifications have developed around the world, all with their own parameters, but typically built around 3 core pillars:

- Environment – farming in a way that preserves the land and vineyards for future generations through water & waste management, energy efficiency, promoting biodiversity; and improving soil health.
- Economy – business practices that are profitable for both owners and employees, building stable, long term growth in the industry.
- Community - promoting diversity and social equity in the workplace while cultivating positive relationships with stakeholders and within their communities.
